

How to install a fall cankerworm sticky band



Step 1:

A. Roll the tar paper around the tree so that it overlaps slightly. Position the paper approximately 3-4 feet from the ground. This will be the base of the sticky band.

B. Cut the tar paper to the proper length so that it fits snugly around the tree trunk without leaving a gap between the ends. Having another person to help makes installation much easier.





Step 2:

One person holds the tar paper tight to the tree trunk while another begins to wrap the duct tape around the base of the paper.





Step 3:

Repeat the process and wrap the tape around the top of the tar paper. Any gaps in the tape can allow cankerworms to crawl underneath.



Step 4:

Spray the Tanglefoot aerosol onto the tar paper from 3 inches away, covering it completely and evenly. The photo shows a completed fall cankerworm sticky band.
