

AFFIDAVIT FOR DEMOLITION OF ACCESSORY STRUCTURES

The standard procedure for obtaining a demolition permit in Fairfax County requires an applicant to contact electric, gas, and water utility companies to obtain written verification of disconnection of their utility service prior to permit issuance. This demolition affidavit provides the property owner or owner's agent the opportunity to certify that no utilities (e.g., natural gas, electricity, water, sewer) have ever served the accessory structure, which is to be demolished. It must be filled out and signed by the property owner or owner's agent. By signing this affidavit you are affirming that the structure is not and has never been served by electricity, natural gas, public water, or public sewer, and you will be accepting responsibility for the work performed under the permit. This form must be sworn to and notarized and must be submitted prior to issuance of a permit for demolition. If you have any questions, please call the Permits Division at (703) 222-0801 prior to signing this form. Copies of signed affidavits are unacceptable. (Please print or type.)
