



## FAIRFAX COUNTY TREE CONSERVATION AWARDS

### TREE PLANTING AWARD NOMINATION

**Tree Planting Awards** for are presented to recognize those developers who have done an outstanding job of replacing trees that were unavoidably destroyed due to development. Nominees shall have made a commitment toward tree conservation in planning and implementation by planting the most suitable species based on post-development conditions and providing for the long-term survival of planted trees. Special consideration will be given to planting that takes advantage of energy conservation opportunities, provides air and/or water quality benefits, and wildlife benefits; as well as the use of species native to Fairfax County, and improved cultivars and varieties. Preferred nominations will also include Low Impact Development (LID) features such as bio-retention and vegetative swales to reduce stormwater and improve water quality, and natural landscaping techniques to conserve resources and reduce maintenance dependent on petroleum products.

#### **Categories for Awards**

- Subdivision Plan: Single-family residential
- Site Plan: Townhouse, Multi-family, Commercial, or Industrial
- Infill Lot Grading Plan: Development of single lot

**Note:** Projects eligible for tree preservation and planting awards must be substantially complete, as evident from the following minimum requirements:

- \* Subdivision Plan: RUP issued for 75% or more of lots
- \* Site Plan: RUP/non-RUP issued for 75% or more of buildings on the site
- \* Infill Lot Grading Plan: RUP issued
- \* Other: determined on case by case basis depending on nature of project
