


Design and Construction

Based on the initial concept provided by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, this complex project may take three to five years to design and an additional two years to construct (from November 2012). Phase I of the project design is complete, and phase II is currently underway. The following tasks will be performed as part of phase II:



- Acquisition of property and easements not owned by the county
- Review and permit approvals from federal, state and county agencies
- Detailed design of the levee and preparation of construction documents
- Pumping station design and preparation of construction documents
- Design of drainage structures
- Analysis of the interior drainage system
- Design modifications to the sanitary sewer system
- Evaluation of the storm drainage system
- Roadway designs and modifications
- Utility design and relocation
- Grading
- Erosion and sediment control
- Construction sequencing
- Other items as they become identified during the design phase

Project Timeline

The county is proceeding on the following schedule:

- Project Design Phase I (*June 2013 - Jan. 2014*)
 1. Data Collection
 2. Site Study
 3. Conceptual Design
- Project Design Phase II (*Jan. 2014 - Winter 2017*)
 1. Schematic Design
 2. Design Development
 3. Construction Documents
 4. Permitting
 5. Land Acquisition
 6. Bidding
- Construction (*Winter 2017 - Spring 2019*)
