### LEGEND

**Facility ID number** – The facility ID number is an alphanumeric designation chosen by the designer to identify the facility on the construction plans.

**Facility Type** – The facility type shall be chosen from the list in Attachment B.

**Purpose** – There are three possible purposes for a facility. The first is to provide water quality control. The second is to provide water quantity control. The third is provide both water quality and water quantity control. The purpose column shall be filled out with “Water Quality”, “Water Quantity”, or “Both.”

**Acres (Hectares) Treated** – This column shall indicate the area treated by the facility. Area treated should only include that area which is being treated, not area which is just passing through the facility.

**Watershed** – This column shall indicate into what major watershed (as shown on the County Map of Watersheds) the facility discharges.

**Receiving Waters** – This column shall indicate into what receiving waters (as listed in Attachment C and shown on the County tax maps) the facility discharges. If the facility discharges into a tributary of the receiving waters, then the designation shall be “Unknown tributary to \_\_\_\_\_.” The blank space shall be labelled with the first downstream known receiving water.

**Maintenance Agreement Y/N** – If the facility is private, it shall be noted that a maintenance agreement is required for the SWM or BMP facility.

**VAHU6Code** – The Virginia 6<sup>th</sup> order hydrologic unit (VAHU6) code for the discharge point of the facility shall be noted. These codes are provided on the Virginia Department of Conservation and Recreation website at <http://192.206.31.57/pages/FtpVANWBD.pdf>
