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SOLID WASTE COLLECTION COMPANIES ANNUAL PERMIT PROCESS

Chapter 109.1 of the Code of Fairfax County currently requires all collection permits to be renewed annually. Current Fiscal Year permits must be on vehicles before they can operate in Fairfax County.

Collection companies are hereby advised to complete their permit renewal applications in a timely manner. The entire permitting process includes: completion of truck inspections, submitting an administratively-complete permit application, presentation of an appropriate surety bond and Statement of Service, and payment of the required permit fees.

Collection companies that have not submitted a complete permit application and paid the appropriate fees will be charged at the penalty rate of \$100 per ton until such time as the permit process is completed. Further, collectors that have not completed the permit process by their designated deadline date will not be able to legally provide collection service in Fairfax County and will not be able to dispose at county facilities.

Reminder: Fairfax County requires old vehicle permit plates to be returned to a county disposal facility. If old plates are not returned, a fee of \$30 per plate will be assessed to the account on the monthly invoice.
