***ADOPTION OF AN AMENDMENT TO
CHAPTER 105 (POLLUTION OF STATE WATERS)
OF THE 1976 CODE OF THE COUNTY OF FAIRFAX, VIRGINIA***

At a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Fairfax County, Virginia, held in the Board Auditorium of the Government Center at Fairfax, Virginia, on Tuesday, January 28, 2014, the Board after having first given notice of its intention so to do, in the manner prescribed by law, adopted an amendment regarding Chapter 105 (Pollution of State Waters) of the 1976 Code of the County of Fairfax, Virginia, said amendment so adopted being in the words and figures following, to-wit:

***BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF FAIRFAX COUNTY,
VIRGINIA:***

That the Code of the County of Fairfax, Virginia, is amended by repealing Chapter 105 (Pollution of State Waters), in its entirety, as follows:

CHAPTER 105 (POLLUTION OF STATE WATERS)

Article 1. General Provisions.

Section 105-1-1. Pollution of state waters.

~~(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge, deposit or cause or allow to be discharged or deposited in any state waters of this County any wastes, rubbish, trash, garbage, dirt, soil, sand, silt, clay, oil or any matter causing or aiding pollution or to discharge, deposit or cause or allow to be discharged or deposited any wastes, rubbish, trash, garbage, dirt, soil, sand, silt, clay, oil or any matter causing or aiding pollution on any property in this County in any manner so as to allow such to be washed into any State waters by storm or flood water.~~

~~(b) "Pollution" and "state waters," as used in this Section shall be as defined by § 62.1-44.3, Va. Code Ann.~~

~~(c) Nothing contained in this Section shall prohibit the discharge or deposit of waste into state waters when such discharging has been approved by the State Water Control Board.~~

This amendment shall become effective on July 1, 2014 at 12:01 a.m.
