





# EMBARK RICHMOND HIGHWAY TRANSPORTATION



RICHMOND HIGHWAY EXPRESS BUS SERVICE

Current Countywide policies address the need for a multimodal transportation system that includes pedestrian, bicycle, transit, and vehicular connectivity.



- + The Richmond Highway Corridor is served by Fairfax County Connector and Washington Metropolitan Transit Authority (WMATA) Richmond Highway Express (REX) buses. Fairfax Connector Route 171 provides transit service from the Huntington Metro Station to the Lorton VRE station. REX provides limited stop service from the King Street-Old Town Metro Station to Fort Belvoir.
- + Currently, pedestrian and bicycle access is challenging due to numerous curb cuts, inadequate or missing sidewalks, wide intersections, and heavy vehicular traffic.
- + Attractive, high-quality, and well connected pedestrian and bicycle facilities are needed to accommodate future growth, and appropriately meet the diverse travel demands and abilities of Richmond Highway residents and stakeholders.
