



2009 Fairfax County Environmental Excellence Awards

Purpose

The Fairfax County Excellence Awards recognize County residents, organizations, businesses and County employees who dedicate time and energy to benefit the environment and support County environmental initiatives. Nominations will be accepted in each of these four categories.

Criteria

- The nominee clearly contributed to the advancement and support of County environmental goals by devoting time, effort, or expertise beyond normal work / civic responsibilities and expectations.
- The nominee served as a model for individuals and communities to follow.
- The achievement must have occurred during the period of eligibility or over a period of years including a portion of the eligibility period. It may be for a specific service, accomplishment or for an accumulation of accomplishments.

Submission Requirements

- The nominator must notify the nominee(s) of their nomination.
- Separate nomination forms must be used for each nomination. Forms may be copied.
- You can submit more than one nomination and can submit nominations in as many categories as you'd like.
- Include a statement of up to two pages in length describing the contribution, with details of the nominee's role and the extent to which the contribution has benefited Fairfax County.
- Include detailed supporting evidence that shows the worth of the contribution in terms of results achieved or the potential for future results and how the contribution was extraordinary or unusual.
- [Optional] Include up to three supportive exhibits, such as testimonials, news articles, photographs, resumes and biographical documents. The exhibits must be reproducible.
