## Police

### General Information

- » Served by Sully and Fair Oaks District police stations
- » Fair Oaks District Station under renovation
- » Police heliport in need of renovation or possible reconstruction
- » Public safety headquarters to be relocated from Massey Building to a new facility adjacent to the Herry Building
- ◇ Will serve as headquarters for the police department and fire and rescue department.
- ◇ Tentative occupancy date is August-September 2016



## Fire + Rescue

### General Information

- » Served by the Fair Oaks Fire and Rescue Station 21 and the Fairfax Center Fire and Rescue Station 40 (county-owned, but also a volunteer station). The Centreville Volunteer Fire and Rescue Station 17 also provides some coverage.
- » Two funded capital projects for facilities in the Fairfax Center Area
  - ◇ Station 21 undergoing minor renovations in conjunction with the major expansion of the Fair Oaks District Police Station
  - ◇ Expansion of existing Fire and Rescue Training Academy
