


Public Facilities: Schools + Libraries

Schools

General Information

- » 20 schools serve the Fairfax Center Area
- » Within the next six years, 12 of the 20 schools are projected to be over capacity, with a significant and slight deficit at the high school and elementary school levels, respectively.
- » Fairfax County Public Schools recently completed a boundary study for Fairfax High School and Lanier Middle School. A majority of the changes from the study will become effective in the 2014-2015 school year.
- » Several capital improvement projects recently completed/underway including:
 - ◇ Modular capacity enhancements at Frost Middle School
 - ◇ Capacity enhancements at Fairfax Villa, Greenbriar, and Union Mill Elementary schools
 - ◇ Renovation and capacity enhancements for Oakton High School and Rocky Run, and Frost Middle Schools
- » There is a need for a new Fairfax/Oakton area elementary school

General Information

- » County libraries are divided into two categories:
 - ◇ Regional Library
 - ◇ Community Library
- » Four libraries service the Fairfax Center Area:
 - ◇ City of Fairfax Regional Library
 - ◇ Chantilly Regional Library
 - ◇ Centreville Regional Library
 - ◇ Oakton Community Library
- » Currently there are no libraries located within the Fairfax Center Area; however there may be an opportunity to expand the role of the Access Services branch located of the Fairfax County Government Center.
