The Fairfax County Trails and Bicycle Master Plans show existing and planned pedestrian and bicycle routes within the Fairfax Center Area. The Comprehensive Plan for the Fairfax Center Area calls for comprehensive and coordinated walkway networks within this area and greater inter-parcel and intra-parcel connectivity. This effort should include the identification of appropriate street crossing locations and features.
