

Reston Master Plan Special Study Community Input Questionnaire

The Reston Master Plan consists of three maps created in 1962 by Robert E. Simon, the original developer of Reston:

- a Land Use Plan map,
- a Community Facilities Plan map, and
- a Transportation Plan map.

These three maps were amended over time by the various Master Developers of Reston but there was never public input to changes to the Reston Master Plan.

There is no longer a Master Developer for Reston and the community is beginning a process to consider how to plan for future development and redevelopment in Reston.

Below are questions used by staff in the Fairfax County Department of Planning and Zoning when meeting with several focus groups in July-October 2008 to initiate a dialogue about residents', employees' and employers' thoughts about Reston.
