Town of Herndon Metro Area Study Community Workshop

As Metro's new Silver Line construction advances westward, the Town of Herndon is preparing for the opening of the Herndon-Monroe Metrorail stop, located in the median of the Dulles Toll Road adjacent to the existing park-and-ride garage on Sunrise Valley Drive. A pedestrian bridge will connect the station to land within the Town of Herndon, on the south side of Herndon Parkway. The project is planned for completion in 2016.

What is YOUR vision for the coming of Metrorail to Herndon?

Your input is vital to the process. Join us for a Community Workshop, facilitated by VHB, the town's project consultant.

In an "open house" format that includes large and small group sessions, we will discuss
