Reston Master Plan - Scenario G

- Proposed Development Would Generate:
 - 1,608 Elementary School Students
 - 425 Middle School Students
 - 880 High School Students
- Estimates based on number of each proposed unit type multiplied by the student yield ratio of the unit type.
- Student yield ratio based on county-wide averages of actual student yields of unit type.

School Capacity Needs

- 2 New Elementary Schools (Reston)
 - *1 New Elementary School per CIP (West County ES)*
- 1 Middle School (Existing + Reston + Innovation)
- 1-2 High Schools (Existing + Reston + Innovation)
 - *1 New High School per CIP (Southwest County HS)*
