- Staff suggests using **Vision Report** (dated March 12, 2011, available on website) as **primary reference** for preparing draft Plan text to be augmented by subcommittee reports as appropriate – the points included below are representative and not intended to be all inclusive
 - **Transportation/Connectivity** – Vision Report subheadings
 - Expand Pedestrian and Bike Access
 - Provide Transit Options
 - Expand the Network of Streets
 - Improve Operational Performance
 - Address Levels of Congestion and Expand Capacity
 - Expand Evaluation Technique
 - **Parks/Open Space/Recreation** –
 - Protect Resource Management Areas (from Vision Report Environment section)
 - Wetlands
 - Streams and Buffer Areas
 - Restore and Enhance (from Environment section)
 - Intermittent Streams
 - Lakes and Ponds
 - Forests and Trees
 - Other Natural Features and Stormwater Management
 - Parks and Recreation needs (as identified in Vision Report Public Facility section)
 - Major city park
 - Linear park
 - Small urban parks
 - Small public or private recreational facilities (e.g. basketball court, private pool, etc.)
 - Large indoor recreation center
 - Public active recreation – e.g. 50 m. pool, tennis, handball, volleyball
 - Sports fields
 - Community park in south Reston Town Center TSA (TC Subcommittee Report)
 - Also reference Fairfax County Park Authority’s Urban Park Standards
