Subject: Comments — Version 2 of the Reston Master Plan Working Draft

Thank you for the opportunity to submit comments on Version 2 of the Reston Master Plan Working Draft document.

The following comments are offered on behalf of The Master Arts Plan (MAP) Task Force, which was formed by the Arts Council of Fairfax County (ACFC) in response to the charge from the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors contained in the Comprehensive Plan Visual and Performing Arts Amendment (adopted May 2010). The comments are in accord with the MAP Task Force 2014 Report, which call for engagement with County Planning.

Specifically, we support the inclusion of the language in Version 2 that calls for:

- Providing outstanding architecture and public art for place making (p. 6)
- Encouraging public art in future development in Reston (p. 9)
- Including a strong institutional component for "...a major fine and performing arts center, other civic and cultural uses..." (p. 9)
- Integrating high-quality public art (p. 10), and
- Collaborative planning and implementation of various facilities as articulated in the Parks and Recreation section (p. 38).

Again, thank you for your endeavors and for the opportunity to support the draft language in Version 2, as noted above.
