



**Draft Meeting Summary**  
**March 10, 2008, 7:00 p.m.**  
**Fairfax County Chamber of Commerce**

- I. Call to Order
- II. Meeting Summary: The summaries of the February 11, February 19, and February 29 Task Force meetings were approved as submitted.
- III. Summary & Discussion of Workshop Findings: Doug Sarno of The Perspectives Group briefed the Task Force members on the [major themes from the three February Workshops](#). Mr. Sarno shared with the members that there were approximately 200 attendees (not including staff and Task Force members), half of which were first time participants, and that the number of positive feedback from the participants greatly outweighed negative comments.
- IV. Process to Develop Preferred Alternative: The Task Force took a few minutes to review the [memo from GB Arrington of PB PlaceMaking to Chairman Clark Tyler](#). After reviewing the document, the Task Force made several comments and requests:
  - The memo does not reflect major underpinnings of the Preferred Alternative, such as key environmental concerns, and the PB PlaceMaking document has some inconsistency with information provided by the Perspectives Group.
  - The Task Force asked that PB PlaceMaking and The Perspectives Group coordinate with each other on what they had learned from the February Workshops, so that their documents are consistent in the future.
  - The Task Force asked staff to follow up with PB PlaceMaking to establish dates for two half-day or an all-day work session to address concerns brought up by the Task Force.
  - In addition, PB PlaceMaking was asked to provide a straw man of the preferred alternative, and the materials describing the consultant's draft preferred alternative should be provided one week in advance of the Task Force work session.

The Task Force agreed that they will submit comments regarding GB's memo, the 80-page document, and the consensus report to Sterling Wheeler by 12:00 pm, Monday, March 17, which would be forwarded to PB PlaceMaking.

- V. Report of Transportation Subcommittee: Keith Turner and Leonard Wolfenstein indicated the Transportation Subcommittee met on March 6<sup>th</sup> and they discussed additional analysis that is needed from Cambridge Systematics. Additional transportation findings will be provided at the March 24<sup>th</sup> Task Force meeting.
- VI. Report of Implementation Subcommittee: They met on March 7<sup>th</sup> to continue to refine aspects of implementation.
- VII. Report of Communication Subcommittee: They met on March 6<sup>th</sup> and reviewed the Perspectives Group's summary of major themes from the February Workshops.
- VIII. Next meeting / adjournment: The next Task Force meeting will be held on March 24<sup>th</sup>. The focus will be on additional transportation analysis and the wastewater management analysis.
