For tax year 2011, the Fairfax County Board of Supervisors has adopted a lower Car Tax rate of \$0.01 per \$100 of assessed value on one (1) vehicle that is owned and regularly used by a qualifying disabled veteran in accordance with Virginia Code §58.1-3506(A)(19).

Co-ownership does not prevent a disabled veteran from qualifying for the lower rate. However, by statute the reduced rate does not apply to a vehicle owned solely by a spouse or a surviving spouse.

DTA will review your application and contact you directly if further information is required. Otherwise, DTA will notify you once your application and reduced tax rate has been approved. By statute, only one vehicle may be taxed at the lower rate for each qualifying disabled veteran.

The reduced Car Tax rate is subject each year to adoption by the Board of Supervisors during their deliberation on the County's annual budget. Disabled Veterans need only apply once, but must contact DTA to receive the lower rate on a different vehicle should the approved vehicle be otherwise moved, sold or disposed.

Pursuant to Va. Code, Article 2.3, §58.1-3219.5 and 3219.6, the County now also offers a real estate exemption program for qualifying disabled veterans.
