Information concerning Election Officer Training

April – June 2012

Training Classes will continue to be offered from April 16 to June 1, 2012, and will fulfill the State Board of Elections current mandate for training. Additional classes will be held in Fall 2012. All sessions will be listed on the Fairfax County Office of Elections website as soon as the dates are set.

- All Election Officers, Chief and Assistant Officers must have completed a current 101 or 102 level class, appropriate to the position they are serving in, before serving in any future Fairfax County election, *beginning with the June 2012 primaries.*
- **Advance registration is required for all classes and workshops** as space is limited for each session in order to provide proper hands-on training. (Prompt registration is encouraged to secure a specific date or time.)
- **To register**, provide your name, phone number and *indicate a first and second class choice*. Your class will be confirmed ONLY if your first class choice is not available.

Additional classes will not be added to the schedule in June due to severe space constraints at the Government Center that week. Please do not wait until the last minute to volunteer to serve or to register for a class. Remember: you must be trained in 2012 before serving again!
