1 Record your vote

To vote for a person not on the ballot for an office, write the name on the line provided and **COMPLETELY** fill in the oval to the left of that name.

Do not use an X or ✓

2 Review your ballot

Before you place your ballot into the ballot box or scanner, double-check your votes.

If a ballot contains too many votes for one contest or question, votes for that contest or question will not be counted. The correct contests and questions will be counted.

You do not have to vote for all contests and questions, you may choose to skip a contest or question. The other contests will be counted.

! If you make a mistake:

If you make a mistake, do not cross out or erase. Write **VOID** across the ballot and then ask the officer of election for a new ballot.
