

# Voter Participation in the June 14th, 2005 Primary Elections Fairfax County, VA

On June 14<sup>th</sup>, 2005 the Commonwealth of Virginia held concurrent Democratic and Republican primary elections. Unofficial elections results are presented on this map and are intended to graphically display primary election participation.

The Republican primary had voters choosing Republican candidates for Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and Attorney General in every precinct. Additionally there were primary contests for House of Delegate candidates in the 35<sup>th</sup>, 37<sup>th</sup>, 41<sup>st</sup>, and 67<sup>th</sup> Districts.


The Democratic primary had voters choosing Democratic candidates for Lieutenant Governor in every precinct. Additionally there were primary contests for House of Delegate candidates in the 37<sup>th</sup> and 45<sup>th</sup> Districts.

Voters could not vote in both primaries. Voters chose which primary to participate in and were excluded from voting in the alternate party's primary.

The graphic displays voter participation as a percentage of total registered voters, and between the two party's primaries. This map should be seen as an exploratory graphic examining voting geography based on primary participation.



#### % of Registered Voters who Voted




### VA House of Delegate Districts
