INTRODUCTION

The Program & Services Division (PSD) of the Defense Facilities Directorate (DFD) has developed this document to assist Department of Defense (DoD) employees relocating to the Mark Center in the City of Alexandria, as a result of BRAC 133. The document provides information on alternative modes of travel to and from the new BRAC 133 facility, and contains a summary of the transportation providers and programs in the National Capital Region (NCR) that are available to commuters for traveling to/from the Mark Center. This is only a summary of the existing options, and is not meant to be an all inclusive list of options. DFD/PSD has developed this reference guide in an effort to reduce employee confusion and present the various commuter options, particularly for those employees who do not receive parking privileges or who choose to use alternative modes of transportation.

All prices or schedules listed in this document are subject to change per each agency and or program. DFD/PSD has no control or responsibility for any of the public and private agencies pricing or schedules. DFD/PSD is only responsible for the existing DoD Shuttle Program and upcoming BRAC 133 Shuttle Program (both Shuttle Programs are detailed later in this guide).

BRAC 133 BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Numerous realignment and closure actions for several DoD organizations and domestic military installations were recommended by the BRAC Commission to reduce the costs of administration and operations of the Armed Forces and to achieve greater cost efficiency. These recommendations became law and were implemented.

One such recommendation, termed BRAC 133, involved the relocation of various defense agency personnel and activities from leased space within the NCR to Fort Belvoir, Virginia. The proposed relocation required about 1.75 million square feet of existing or newly constructed office space and 1.3 million square feet of associated parking facilities. Due to several considerations and limitations within Fort Belvoir, alternative relocation sites throughout Northern Virginia were evaluated. The Mark Center development was chosen as the site for a portion of the relocation.

The Mark Center is a mixed-use business park located in Alexandria, Virginia. The BRAC 133 facility site plan displays 1.8 million square feet of office space in two towers located on the southwest corner of the site. Parking structures are located to the south of the office buildings along I-395 (the South Parking Garage) and on the north side of the site (the North Parking Garage). The North Parking Garage will include a publicly accessible community Transportation Center, with five (5) bus bays, which provide multiple transportation options for DoD employees as well as for Mark Center commuters and visitors.

PURPOSE

The purpose of this BRAC 133 Transportation Reference Guide is to provide employees relocating to the Mark Center with reference information that will assist them in determining transportation to and from the site. Specifically, the goal of this Transportation Reference Guide is to prepare employees to make informed decisions in selecting alternative transportation modes—modes other than driving alone—thereby increasing participation in the WHS Transportation Management Program’s various commute alternatives.

REGIONAL COMMUTER PROGRAM INFORMATION

DoD MASS TRANSPORTATION BENEFIT PROGRAM

Effective October 1, 2000, Executive Order 13150, “Federal Workforce Transportation in the NCR,” allows qualified federal employees to participate in a transportation fringe benefit program. Pursuant to this Executive Order, Washington Headquarters Services (WHS) is managing this program for DoD employees throughout the NCR and is assisted by the Department of Transportation (DoT) in its implementation.

Under this program, participating employees will receive, in addition to their current compensation, “transit passes” in amounts equal to their personal commuting costs (not to exceed \$230/month). This benefit applies to both mass transit and qualified vanpool participants. Parking costs will not be used in establishing commuter costs. As a result, employees with subsidized parking must relinquish their parking permits in order to receive transit passes.

Similarly, employees who receive transit passes may not be counted as part of a DoD carpool for purposes of qualifying for a parking pass. Servicing parking offices will have the authority to make exceptions to this rule. If an exception occurs, such offices will notify WHS. If you have questions, please contact your local parking office for additional information/guidelines.

GUARANTEED RIDE HOME (GRH) PROGRAM

Guaranteed Ride Home (GRH) is a free service administered by Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOC) to provide Washington Metropolitan Area commuters – who regularly carpool, vanpool, bicycle, walk, or take public transit to work—a free ride home in the event of a personal emergency or if they work late at a supervisor’s request. Commuters can use this service up to four times a year. If a commuter misses his/her ride home, GRH will arrange for a taxi, rental car, or paratransit service provider to provide the ride home. Members are issued a GRH card to be presented to the emergency ride driver as validation.

Upon enrollment into the WHS Transportation Management Program, all employees will be notified by the Transportation Coordinator to verify acceptance of automatic enrollment into the GRH program. All employees who regularly carpool, vanpool, bicycle, walk, and/or take public transit must register into the GRH program. Information on the GRH program will be posted on the WHS Transportation Management Program web page, as well as advertised at the WHS Transportation Management Program Office.

COMMUTER CONNECTIONS

Commuter Connections is a regional network of transportation organizations coordinated by the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments. If you live or work in the Metropolitan Washington D.C. area, Commuter Connections can provide you with information on all your commute options, so you can make a smart choice about how you travel to work. Commuter Connections also helps employers establish commuting benefits and assistance programs, including telework/telecommute programs, for their employees.

Commuter Connections was originally created in 1974 as the Commuter Club, providing one of the first computerized carpool matching systems in the nation. The Commuter Club network consisted of the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG), General Services Administration (GSA), and the Greater Washington Board of Trade. COG provided the direct ridematching services to the public. This service is provided free to anyone who requests ridematching information. In the 1980's, the local government agencies of City of Alexandria, Fairfax County, Montgomery County, Prince William County, and the Northern Virginia Transportation Commission joined the network. The Commuter Club network members used COG's ridematching software and shared one regional database for ridematching. It was in the mid-1980's that the network changed its name to the RideFinders Network. By 1994 the network had grown in membership to include all Washington D.C. area local governments, a few federal agencies, several Transportation Management Associations, and government agencies from the Baltimore area, southern Maryland, and northern Virginia. In 1996 and 1997, the services provided by the RideFinders Network had grown beyond just carpool/vanpool matching to include transit route and schedule information, a regional Guaranteed Ride Home program, bicycle to work information, park-and-ride lot and HOV lane information, telecommute/telework program assistance, InfoExpress commuter information kiosks, commuter information services through our Internet site, and employer services. It was in 1996 that the network changed its name to Commuter Connections.

Commuter Connections is a program of the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board at the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments and is funded by the District, Maryland and Virginia Departments of Transportation as well as the U.S. Department of Transportation. Many of the local Commuter Connections members receive grant funding directly from their respective state government.

DOD SHUTTLE PROGRAM

EXISTING 12-ROUTE DOD SHUTTLE PROGRAM

The current DoD Shuttle Program consists of 12 shuttle routes operating out of the Pentagon, as presented in the figure below. Existing shuttle routes link the Pentagon Transit Center with numerous DoD facility locations currently housing thousands of the DoD employees, contractors, and enlisted personnel. Appendix A of this Reference Guide includes the schedules for all 12 routes. Please note that several of these routes will be adjusted as BRACs throughout the NCR are established.




Figure 1: Existing 12-route DoD Shuttle Program

BRAC 133 SHUTTLE PROGRAM

WHS is currently developing a viable DoD Shuttle Bus Program between the BRAC 133 facility and various Metrorail stations in the vicinity. The current BRAC 133 Shuttle Bus Program features four routes, which will operate from 5:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. five days a week. It is planned to run during peak hours (from 6:00 to 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 to 6:00 p.m.) with 10- and 15-minute headways (frequency). During off-peak times, the buses will service the King Street Shuttle Route and Pentagon Shuttle Route with 30-minute headways/frequency. The DoD shuttle service anticipates transporting 5,000 passengers during the peak hours and an additional 1,800 passengers during off-peak times. DoD federal employees and contractors will be able to utilize these shuttles to and from the BRAC 133 facility at the Mark Center from the locations listed below. The following bullets present additional information on the four shuttle routes to the facility:

- Pentagon Shuttle Route will be operated by the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority as route 7M from Bus Bay U5 at the Pentagon Transit Center (PTC).
- King Street Shuttle Route will be operated by DASH as Route AT2 Express from the King Street Metrorail station.
- West Falls Church Shuttle Route will be operated by a contractor through the Office of the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army (OAA) from the West Falls Church Metrorail station.
- Franconia-Springfield Shuttle Route will be operated by a contractor through the Office of the Administrative Assistant to the Secretary of the Army (OAA) from the Franconia-Springfield Metrorail station.

BRAC 133 (Mark Center) Shuttle Routes




Figure 2: BRAC 133 Shuttle Program

EXISTING TRANSPORTATION PROVIDERS

**(LOCAL SYSTEMS TO
PRIVATE PROVIDERS)**

PURPOSE

The following text provides a detailed summary of existing transit providers in and around the Washington Metropolitan area, specifically noting routes that travel through Arlington, Virginia; Alexandria, Virginia; the District of Columbia; Pentagon Transit Center; and BRAC 133 facility. Identifying these providers allowed the planning team to recognize coordination opportunities for potential service to the BRAC 133 facility at the Mark Center. The following transit providers are organized by the type of service they provide in the Washington DC Metropolitan Area.

LOCAL PUBLIC SYSTEM

Arlington Transit (ART)

ART is a local bus system operated within Arlington County, Virginia, which provides supplemental service to neighborhoods not currently served by Metrobus. Residents in these areas use ART to gain access to Metrorail and the VRE. Currently, ART operates two environmentally friendly buses that serve the Pentagon Metrorail station: the ART 42 and ART 87. The ART 42 bus operates weekdays with service between the Ballston Metrorail station and the Pentagon Metro station. The ART 87 bus provides Monday through Saturday service from the Shirlington Metrobus station to the Pentagon Metrorail station.

ART offers residents a base fare of \$1.50 that can be paid by cash or Regional SmarTrip Card; a senior/disabled discount; and iRide Teen Discount tokens. Gold ART full-fare tokens, Regional Bus Transfers, and Metrobus regular tokens are also accepted for the base fare.

ALEXANDRIA TRANSIT COMPANY – DASH

The Alexandria Transit Company's DASH system provides bus service within the City of Alexandria, and connects with various other public transit systems, including Metrobus, Metrorail, VRE commuter rail, and all local bus systems. The DASH system specifically serves all WMATA Metrorail stations and the Pentagon Metrorail station during morning and evening peak hours.

Currently, in the City of Alexandria, DASH has two routes, AT3 and AT4, traveling through the PTC Bus Bay L7, from 5:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m. and from 1:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. Route AT3 Northbound begins at Hunting Towers in Alexandria, Virginia, travels through Old Town Alexandria, makes one of several stops at the Braddock Road Metrorail station, and terminates at the Pentagon. Route AT4 Northbound begins in Old Town Alexandria, makes one of several stops at the Braddock Road Metrorail station, and ends at the Pentagon.

Pursuant to BRAC 133, DASH presently operates one route, AT2, which commences on Braddock Road Metrorail station, travels on several roads, including Seminary Road, making one of several stops at Southern Towers (Beauregard Street), and continuing onto to Landmark Plaza in the City of Alexandria. DASH will also be providing direct transit service from the King Street Metrorail station to designated bus stops located at the Mark Center Transit Center and on Mark Center Drive. Two express route structures, labeled Route AT2 Express, will be established. One will operate via King Street, Janney's Lane, Seminary Road, and Mark Center Drive. The other route will operate via Duke Street, Quaker Lane, Seminary Road, and Mark Center Drive. Both routes will be utilized dependent on the time of day and direction.

DASH offers residents a base fare of \$1.50, free transfers upon boarding, a monthly DASH PASS, and children under 4 with an adult ride for free. The company honors the Regional SmarTrip Card, Metrobus Full Fare Weekly Pass, and Transit Link Card. Regional Bus Transfers and Metrobus regular tokens are also accepted for the base fare.

DASH will allow all passengers with official DoD employee identification to ride all regularly scheduled DASH buses in fixed-route service both to and from BRAC 133 and throughout the system at no additional charge.

WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREA TRANSIT AUTHORITY (WMATA)

The Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority (WMATA/Metro) is an interstate compact agency of the District of Columbia, State of Maryland, and Commonwealth of Virginia. WMATA was created to plan, finance, construct, and operate a comprehensive mass transit system for the Washington Metropolitan Area and its Virginia and Maryland suburbs. The transit authority currently operates the second largest rail transit system, known as Metrorail, and the sixth largest bus network, known as Metrobus, in the United States. Metrorail and Metrobus serve a population of 3.5 million within a 1,500-square-mile area.

Today, Metrorail serves 86 stations along five lines – Blue, Green, Orange, Red and Yellow. Metrobus serves the area 24 hours a day, seven days a week with 1,500 buses and 319 routes on 174 lines. Both the Metrorail and Metrobus connect with various other public transit systems, including the MARC commuter rail, VRE commuter rail, Amtrak trains, and several local bus systems.

Currently, the Pentagon Metrorail station stop is serviced by Metrorail and Metrobus. The Metrorail system operates a single stop along the Blue and Yellow lines, while Metrobus operates 59 bus routes from 16 upper and lower level station bus bays.

Pursuant to BRAC 133, WMATA will be providing direct transit service, labeled Route 7M, from the Pentagon Transit Center to the Mark Center Transit Center from 6:00am-9:00am and from 3:00pm-6:00pm.

WMATA offers residents a Metrobus fare of \$1.50 with the Regional SmarTrip Card, \$1.70 using cash, and \$0.75 for Seniors/Disabled individuals. The fare for express routes is \$3.65 using SmarTrip, \$3.85 using cash, and \$1.80 for Seniors/Disabled individuals.

WMATA will allow all passengers with official DoD employee identification to ride Route 7M at no additional charge.

FAIRFAX COUNTY CONNECTOR

The Fairfax County Connector is a public bus service provided by Fairfax County, Virginia, and operated under contract by MV Transportation. The Connector has been in operation for more than 25 years and provides service in North Fairfax County with 25 routes, South Fairfax County with 22 routes, and West Fairfax County with 19 routes. There are 36 Park and Rides served by the Fairfax Connector, including six Metrorail stations:

- Dunn Loring–Merrifield;
- Franconia–Springfield;
- Huntington Metro;
- Van Dorn Street;
- Vienna/Fairfax–George Mason University (GMU);
- West Falls Church/VT–UVA.

Currently, the Fairfax Connector provides bus service to the Pentagon on three routes, the 306 GMU Line, 380D Franconia–Springfield/Pentagon Express Line, and the 595 Pentagon Express route (see table below). The DoD shuttle service will operate from the following locations allowing individuals to link from the Fairfax Connector to the DoD Mark Center shuttles:

- Franconia-Springfield Metrorail station – Fairfax Connector Routes: 171, 231, 232, 301, 304, 305, 310, 321, 401, 402.
- Pentagon Metrorail station – Fairfax Connector Routes: 306, 380D, 595.
- West Falls Church Metrorail station – Fairfax Connector Routes: 425, 427, 480, 505, 551, 552, 553, 554, 557, 585, 950, 980.

The Fairfax Connector offers residents a base fare of \$1.50 with the Regional SmarTrip Card and \$1.70 using cash to ride. The limited stop fare on many of the routes is \$5.00, with a Bus to Bus Transfer for \$3.75, and the Rail to Bus Transfer is \$4.50. The 595 and several other routes the cost is \$5.00 with the Regional SmarTrip Card and \$7.00 using cash.

REGIONAL SYSTEM

Loudoun County Commuter Bus Service

Loudoun County (LC) Transit operates rush hour service from park and ride lots throughout Loudoun to destinations including the West Falls Church Metro Station, Rosslyn, the Pentagon, and Washington, DC. LC Transit enables commuter connections to Metrorail, Metrobus, and the Fairfax Connector.

Currently, LC Transit has five routes traveling through PTC Bus Bay L11. Four of these routes also make stops at the Pentagon South Parking Lot. Morning departures leave from two Purcellville Park and Ride lots, Leesburg Park and Ride, Dulles North Transit Center, and Dulles South Park and Ride.

Maryland Transit Authority (MTA)

The Maryland Transit Authority (MTA) provides Commuter Bus service currently serving both Baltimore and Washington, DC bound commuters from outlying counties. The service operates primarily to peak travel destinations and during peak travel times on weekdays only.




Figure 3: MTA Commuter Bus Service

Omniride

Omniride is the Potomac and Rappahannock Transportation Commission (PRTC) commuter bus service. Service is provided Monday through Friday from locations throughout Prince William County along the I-95 corridor and in the Manassas and Gainesville areas along the I-66 corridor to areas that include the Vienna/Fairfax–GMU, West Falls Church, and Franconia–Springfield Metro stations. COMMUTER RAIL

Maryland Area Regional Commuter (MARC) Train Service

The Maryland Area Regional Commuter (MARC) Train Service is a commuter rail system whose service areas include Harford County, Maryland; Baltimore City; Washington D.C.; Brunswick, Maryland; Frederick, Maryland and Martinsburg, West Virginia.

Penn Line: The Penn Line of the MARC Train Service operates primarily between Baltimore's Penn Station, through BWI Thurgood Marshall Airport Train Station, and Union Station in Washington, D.C. Stops include Baltimore City, Odenton, and Bowie State University. In addition, there are 4 stops north of Penn Station [Martins Airport, Edgewood, Aberdeen, and Perryville] located in Harford County, Maryland. The map below presents the MARC line routes in the State of Maryland. For greater detail please go to MTA's web site (see address below).

Brunswick Line: The Brunswick Line operates between Brunswick, Maryland and Washington Union Station. This line also includes an extension to Frederick, Maryland and Martinsburg, West Virginia. Stops along the Brunswick Line include areas surrounding Washington D.C. such as Gaithersburg, Rockville, and Silver Spring, Maryland.

Camden Line: The Camden Line operates out of Camden Yards in Downtown Baltimore City and travels to Union Station in Washington D.C. Stops include Dorsey, Laurel, and College Park, Maryland.

Virginia Railway Express (VRE)

The VRE is a Monday through Friday commuter rail service that operates from the Northern Virginia suburbs to Washington DC. The VRE system consists of two lines, the Manassas-Blue Line composed of ten stops, and the Fredericksburg-Red Line, consisting of 12 stops.

The Manassas-Blue VRE line currently operates eight northbound trains from Broad Run Airport to Union Station, making stops in areas such as Manassas, Burke Centre, and Backlick Road. Six of these trains depart within the morning peak, making all ten stops between 5:05 a.m. and 7:50 a.m., and two trains depart in the afternoon with limited stops, at 2:45 p.m. and 5:10 p.m. In the afternoon, the blue line operates eight southbound trains from Union Station out to Broad Run Airport. Six of these trains depart within the afternoon peak, 3:45 p.m. to 6:50 p.m., and two depart at 6:25 a.m. and 1:15 p.m.

The Fredericksburg-Red VRE line operates six northbound trains from Fredericksburg to Union Station, making stops along I-95 in areas such as Quantico, Woodbridge, Lorton, and Franconia-Springfield. All of these trains depart within the morning peak, making all 12 stops between 5:15 a.m. and 7:50 a.m. The red line also operates seven southbound trains from Union Station out to Fredericksburg. Six of these trains depart within the afternoon peak, 3:35 p.m. to 6:40 p.m., and one departs Union Station at 12:55 p.m.

Both lines converge in Alexandria, Virginia, at the King Street Metro station and make identical stops at Crystal City, L'Enfant Plaza, and Union Station. As a result, commuters are able to transfer to the Metrorail's Blue and Yellow lines, in all three locations, in order to travel to the Pentagon.

Additionally, passengers riding the VRE have the ability to use Amtrak trains, in conjunction with a Step-Up ticket, for commuter travel, and reverse-flow MARC trains for free. The VRE also connects with the Arlington ART Bus at the Crystal City VRE station; the DASH at the Alexandria (King Street) VRE station; the DC Circulator at the L'Enfant Plaza and Union Station; and the Fairfax Connector at several VRE stations along the Manassas-Blue line.

Martz Trailways

The Martz Trailway’s Gray Line provides roundtrip charter coach service from the Fredericksburg/Richmond, Virginia, area to the Washington, DC Metropolitan Area. The Gray line commuter service operates 12 northbound routes in the morning peak and 11 southbound routes in the afternoon peak.

Within the north- and southbound routes, the Gray Line provides an express bus to the PTC Bus Bay L3. The morning express route departs Fredericksburg from a Route 208 Park and Ride, makes one stop, and terminates at the Pentagon bus bay in about 1 hour and 25 minutes. Within the 11 other northbound routes in the morning, ten make stops at the Pentagon South Parking Lot and one route conducts an additional stop at the PTC Bus Bay L3. The afternoon express route, on the other hand, departs DC, serves the Pentagon with two stops – the Pentagon South Parking Lot and PTC Bus Bay L3 – performs two intermediate stops, and finishes at the Route 208 Park and Ride. Within the remaining ten routes, seven make stops at the Pentagon South Parking Lot.

Additionally, the Gray Line offers a noon shuttle on Fridays, stopping at the Pentagon South Parking Lot just before 1 p.m.

ALTERNATIVE MODES

VANPOOL INFORMATION

Vanpooling is an alternate transportation source utilized by employees to commute to work. A vanpool option is typically chosen when people have at least a 30 minute one-way drive to work. A vanpool consists of 4-15 people who choose to commute to work together on a regular basis. There is typically one individual who volunteers to be the driver and coordinator of the van. There is a flat fee for using the van, which is split amongst all the riders. The riders then will choose a specified pick-up location where everyone meets to commute and then determines the route.

*BRAC 133 Vanpool Permits require a minimum of seven (7) passengers, four (4) of which need to be stationed at the facility.

- Options for Van Acquisition
 - **Owner-operated vans** – An individual leases or purchases a van and operates the van independently. Riders generally meet at a central location and pay the owner a set monthly fee.
 - **Third-party vans** – A vanpool “provider” leases the vanpool vehicle for a monthly fee that includes the vehicle operating cost, insurance, and maintenance. The monthly lease fee is paid by the vanpool subscribers.
 - **Employer-provided vans** – The employer buys or leases vans for employees' commute use. The employer may charge a fee to ride in the van or subsidize the service.

 - Estimate monthly costs
 - Recruit other individuals by notifying potential riders of specified route
 - Designate a driver/coordinator
 - Determine pick-up location

 - Choose a certain calendar date when monthly payment is due

CARPOOL INFORMATION

Encouraging carpooling is one of the most effective ways for employees to find a door-to-door commuting solution. The Transportation Coordinator will develop a carpool (rideshare) program that is geared toward forming BRAC 133 facility employee-only carpools. Carpooling is shared use of a car, in particular for commuting to work, often by people who each have a car but travel together to save costs and in the interest of other socio-environmental benefits. There are sometimes special facilities for carpoolers, including designated pick-up points and high-occupancy vehicle lanes which are opened up to designated cars with multiple riders. Carpool programs have been around in fairly structured form going back to the mid-seventies, and in recent years have begun to make much more extensive use of the internet and software support systems. Carpools may be formed through word of mouth by friends and colleagues, or through online carpooling services.

Bikesharing







MAP 2: EASTBOUND ROUTE FROM GLEN HILLS PARK VIA HOLMES RUN STREAM VALLEY TRAIL



MAP 3: WESTBOUND ROUTE FROM ARLINGTON COUNTY VIA FOUR MILE RUN



An improved signalized crosswalk is in place for left turns from North Beauregard Street onto Mark Center Drive.

MAP 4: NORTHBOUND ROUTE FROM SEMINARY HILL VIA SEMINARY ROAD

Map 4 illustrates a northbound route from Seminary Hill via Seminary Road. The route is about two miles long and about a 10 minute trip to BRAC 133. There is a pedestrian/bicycle bridge on the right side of Seminary Road going northbound that crosses over I-395. There is a signalized intersection at Seminary Road and North Beauregard Street that includes signalized crosswalks to make the left turn along the route.

MAP 5 illustrates an additional northbound route from Cameron Station via Holmes Run Stream Valley Trail. The route is about 2.2 miles long and about a 17 minute trip to BRAC 133. Starting on Holmes Run Stream Valley Trail out of Cameron Station, the route follows N. Pengram Street, Richenbacher Avenue, and Sheffield Court. An improved signalized crosswalk is in place for left turns from North Beauregard Street onto Mark Center Drive.

SLUGGING

Slugging is a phenomenon that has been prominent in the Washington, D.C. region since high-occupancy vehicles (HOV) lanes were introduced on Shirley Highway/Interstate 395 (I-395) in the 1970s. Slugging is an informal, unofficial, local custom which is not sponsored by the U.S. Government/DoD. Although the HOV designation has since been lowered to require only three passengers per vehicle, the slugging phenomenon has remained strong.

Although there is currently no direct access on/off the HOV lanes at Seminary Road, commuters can access the HOV lanes via a slip ramp located approximately 2.5 miles south of Seminary Road. Therefore, it is expected that many BRAC 133 facility employees will make slugging part of their regular commute. The BRAC 133 facility will include a designated slugging area located along Mark Center Drive west of the north parking garage. The area will include signage instructing slugs and drivers about appropriate places to queue safely. As usage of the slugging area is difficult to predict at this time and will likely change over time, WHS will observe slugging operations over time, and may choose in the future to move the slugging area to a different location. During mid-day hours, the slugging area will be available for taxis.


