

Section 82-5-7 of the Fairfax County Code restricts some trailers in residential areas County-wide.

Utility Trailer vs. Cargo Trailer

Single axle utility trailers are permitted, except when used for transporting landscaping or lawn-care equipment or within a Community Parking District (CPD). Any type of enclosed trailer or double axle trailer is not permitted and is not considered a utility trailer. See Section 82-5-7. for "utility trailer" details on page two. If you are within a CPD, all trailer types are prohibited (see page two for links to map locations)

			
			
			
			

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Exceptions: any trailer designed to be used as a camper trailer or boat trailer or a single axle utility trailer unless used for transporting landscaping or lawn-care equipment. These "exempted" vehicles may park in a residential area unless restricted elsewhere in the Code, e.g., boats and motor homes are not allowed to park in areas that are Community Parking Districts (CPD).

"Utility trailer" means: A small non-motorized trailer which is generally pulled by a motorized vehicle and features an open-top rear cargo area.
