


Got the Dot? YELLOW DOT PROGRAM IT COULD SAVE YOUR LIFE

On September 12, 2016, the Fairfax County Fire and Rescue Department launched its newest public safety initiative, the Yellow Dot Program. This free program is designed to help first responders provide life-saving medical attention during the "golden hour" after a vehicle

crash or emergency. Participants place a Yellow Dot decal in their vehicle's rear window to alert first responders to check the vehicle's glove compartment for vital medical information.

To participate, residents can visit their neares**t** Fairfax County fire station and ask for a Yellow
