10:00 a.m. Budget Markup on the County Executive's Proposed FY 2012 Advertised Budget Plan, the Advertised Capital Improvement Program for Fiscal Years 2012-2016 (CIP) (With Future Fiscal Years to 2021) and the Current Appropriation in the FY 2011 Revised Budget Plan

4:00 p.m. A public hearing to consider alternative plans to reapportion the election districts of the Board of Supervisors. State and federal law require the Board, the governing body of Fairfax County, to reapportion the election districts of the Board based on population data from the 2010 Census. Because Fairfax County operates under the urban county executive form of government, state law requires the Board to consist of between five and eleven supervisors elected by district and one Chairman elected at large. The current Board has nine supervisors elected by district, and a Chairman elected at large.

The Board created the Advisory Citizens Committee on the 2011 Reapportionment of the Election Districts of the Board of Supervisors to propose reapportionment plans for the Board's consideration. Additionally, the County established a public webpage containing the tools and data necessary for members of the public to prepare and submit reapportionment plans for consideration. The Advisory Committee has issued a report that includes 25 proposed reapportionment plans created by the Committee and the public. Each of the plans is depicted by a map showing the proposed new boundaries of each district. Each plan also includes a summary sheet showing the precincts and population the plan proposes to move along with basic statistical information; summarized population counts for each district in the proposed plan; a completed questionnaire describing how the plan satisfies legal and Board-imposed requirements; and a proposed ordinance that would effect the changes. The plans provide for nine, ten, or eleven supervisor election districts. The Board will hold the public hearing to consider the plans proposed in the report as well as any amendments thereto that the Board may deem appropriate. Virginia law requires the Board to adopt a reapportionment plan by ordinance in public session.

THEREFORE, ALSO TAKE NOTICE that, at its regular meeting on April 26, 2011, the Board will propose an ordinance for passage and adopt an ordinance amending Fairfax County Code Chapter 7 to reapportion the election districts of the Board of Supervisors in accordance with a plan or plans proposed in the report as well as such amendments that the Board may deem appropriate. Because the reapportionment must comply with legal requirements to balance the population among districts, among other requirements, every voting precinct in the County is potentially affected by being moved into another election district either in whole or in part.

All regular Board meetings are held in the Board Auditorium in the Fairfax County Government Center, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Fairfax, Virginia 22035. Persons wishing to comment on the proposed ordinances may do so by testifying in person at the public hearing on Tuesday, April 12, 2011. Speakers may either register in advance by calling the Clerk to the Board of Supervisors at 703-324-3151 (TDD 703-324-3903), or appear at the scheduled time of public hearing and be heard. Alternatively, comments may be submitted in writing to the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.
