Who Should Be Tested for TB

- People who spend time with someone who has or had TB disease
- People who come from a country where TB disease is common (*most countries in Latin America, the Caribbean, Africa, Asia, Eastern Europe and Russia*)
- People who live or work in high-risk settings (*for example: correctional facilities, long-term care facilities, nursing homes or homeless shelters*) or people who care for patients at an increased risk for TB disease
- Infants, children and/or adolescents exposed to adults who are at increased risk for latent tuberculosis infection or TB disease
- IV Drug users
- People who are sick with other diseases that weakens the immune system, such as diabetes, renal disease or HIV infection



Ask your health care provider about a TB test.
