the first of its kind established by a local government in the United States and serves as a model for local commissions throughout the country.

The Fairfax County Commission on Organ and Tissue Donation and Transplantation is dedicated to increasing the awareness of all citizens of Fairfax County regarding organ and tissue donation and transplantation through education and coordination of resources in a way which will result in increased organ and tissue donations in the county.

Today, there is a critical shortage of organs and tissue needed for transplants.

Approximately 100,000 Americans are waiting for organ transplants, while hundreds of thousands more need tissue transplants. Tragically, many die each year because the organs or tissues they need are not available. You can help save lives by registering to become an organ and tissue donor.
