

As the HUD 2015 CoC Program Competition has begun, there are new funding opportunities available for providers in our community.

Number One:

Permanent Housing Bonus Project funding is available as part of the 2015 Competition. All new projects must provide either Permanent Supportive Housing (PSH) for 100 percent chronically homeless families and/or singles OR Rapid Rehousing (RRH) for families and/or singles coming directly from shelters or the streets.

Amount of funding available: **\$1,140,000.**

There is no requirement on the number of project applications that can be submitted; applicants can apply for all or part of the total funding amount.

The project must provide permanent housing following a housing first model and commit to accept all clients through the Coordinated System.

The project must meet all requirements and regulations of the [Interim Coc Program Rule](#) and the [FY2015 CoC Program NOFA](#).

Number Two:

Reallocated funding is available as part of the 2015 Competition. All new projects created through reallocation must provide either PSH for 100 percent chronically homeless families and/or singles OR RRH for families and/or singles coming directly from shelters or the streets. In addition the funding can be utilized to operate and support the Homeless Management Information System or a Coordinated System.

Amount of funding available: **\$153,602.**

This reallocated funding cannot be combined with Bonus Project funding. It can however be combined with previously awarded reallocated funding. As the awardees received only half of the previously reallocated funding this can be used to further support the initial requests.

If providing permanent housing the project must follow a housing first model and commit to accept all clients through the Coordinated System.

The project must meet all requirements and regulations of the [Interim Coc Program Rule](#) and the [FY2015 CoC Program NOFA](#).

There will be a meeting to discuss details of applying for both funding sources for prospective new projects on Sept. 29 at the Government Center, 12000 Government Center Parkway, Conference Center Room 8 from 1 to 2:00 p.m. Attendance at this meeting is not required but recommended. **Applications are due by Oct. 9 prior to 4 p.m.**
