

Creating Permanent Supportive Housing for Homeless Veterans

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

This face-to-face TA seminar will provide nonprofits with the basic skills to successfully pursue and access funding to develop permanent supportive housing for homeless veterans. The seminar will also focus on the types of resources, including federal resources (e.g., HUD-VA Supported Housing (HUD-VASH) program, McKinney-Vento homeless assistance) and state/local resources, available to create permanent supportive housing. Although not specifically designated for veterans, homeless veterans are eligible to participate in programs funded through HUD's McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Grants, and specifically the Shelter Plus Care (SPC) program and the Supportive Housing Program (SHP). Comprehensive information on specific rules and regulations for these programs will be included.

TARGET AUDIENCE

Mission-driven, homeless veteran nonprofit providers or community-based, nonprofit organizations either interested in applying for funds or currently receiving funding to create and operate permanent housing for homeless veterans.
