Many people are not aware that there are people in our community who, perhaps like you, **struggle to find safe and/or stable place to call home**. This could mean that you can stay with a friend or relative one night but don't know where you will be sleeping next. This could also mean that you are sleeping in your car, in an abandoned house/building or perhaps outside. These are just some examples of unstable housing/homelessness that you or your peers may be experiencing.

Fairfax County wants to hear from you and other people **13-24 years old** who may not have a permanent safe and stable place to stay. We invite you to take a **brief survey** on Wednesday **January 25 at one of the locations listed below**. Talking with you for just a few minutes to find out how many people in this age group are in your situation will help us to plan how we can better help young people like you in the future. We will **NOT** be asking for your name and any **information you share will be kept private**.

Each person who completes the survey will **receive a \$5 gift card**.
