

SENIOR CONSTRUCTION SUPERVISOR

DEFINITION

Under direction, plans and supervises construction and repair of County facilities such as sanitary and storm sewers, streets, sidewalks, stream rehabilitation; and to do related work as required.

TYPICAL TASKS

Plans, assigns and reviews the work of construction and repair crews providing direction and supervision of all phases of execution and reporting each job; insures that personnel and equipment safety practices, regulations, procedures, protective clothing and devices are strictly and continuously followed or utilized; determines construction conditions, tools, machinery and materials required on each job; contacts property owners regarding access to job sites when appropriate; handles citizen complaints; maintains daily report of work accomplished and resources used or expended and significant events; attends meetings and conferences as required.

EMPLOYMENT STANDARDS

Any combination of education and experience equal to the following:

Graduation from high school and one year experience as Construction Supervisor. Three years field experience in excavations, repairs and construction may be substituted for one year experience as a Construction Supervisor.

Knowledge of the methods, specialized equipment, tools, machinery and materials used in facility construction and repair; ability to plan, coordinate and supervise the work of a large number of subordinates; ability to follow written and oral instructions; ability to maintain effective relationships with the public and fellow employees; ability to keep records and prepare reports.
