

## *Detailed Operational Analysis of New Tysons Dulles Toll Road Ramps*

**What:** This study is to identify an optimum configuration for increased ramp connections between Tysons Corner and the Dulles Toll Road (DTR). The additional ramp connections will provide additional access to and from Tysons and the DTR with goals of providing the best traffic flow, being cost effective, and requiring the minimum right-of-way with the least negative impacts to adjacent properties and the environment.

The study will look at the operational analysis of the proposed ramps, the need for collector-distributor lanes along the DTR, impacts to surrounding properties, the desired urban design for Tysons, and mitigation measures to reduce peak period traffic congestion. The conceptual ramp plans will be presented at this public meeting. The public is invited to comment on the concepts.
