Tuesday's Board of Supervisors meeting opened with a moment of silence in remembrance of Stuart Rakoff. Stu's longtime service and commitment to our community will be sorely missed. Our thoughts and prayers are extended to his family.

Among Tuesday's actions, we approved the Board of Supervisors' meeting schedule for 2014. We also took action to reorganize the financing and governmental structure of the Workhouse Arts Center to ensure its long-term sustainability. In order to renovate the Fairfax County-owned Workhouse Arts Center and to provide a cultural arts venue for the community, the Lorton Arts Foundation (LAF) entered into approximately \$60 million dollars of debt. This action protects the historically important Workhouse Arts Center campus, situated on the site of the former Lorton prison. Continued adaptive reuse of this historic property is now possible, ensuring site stabilization and preservation and improved quality of life in the surrounding Laurel Hill community. The Board authorized the purchase of the leasehold interests in the renovated Workhouse Arts Center campus owned by Fairfax County and currently occupied by the Lorton Arts Foundation. This will settle all issues between LAF and Wells Fargo Bank.

Oakcrest School Outreach Meeting: Tuesday, January 21, 2014

At the September 24, 2013 Board of Supervisors' meeting, Supervisor Cathy Hudgins deferred the public hearing for the Oakcrest School Special Exception amendment (SEA 2009-DR-008) that proposed a traffic signal as a replacement for traffic control at the intersection of Crowell and Hunter Mill Road.

A committee with representation from the Oakcrest School, the Community and Fairfax County staff was formed to address concerns expressed regarding the special exception amendment. ~~with~~ The goal was to gain consensus from the community, to develop solutions to address the needs and concerns of both the community and Oakcrest School, and to ~~that would~~ provide a way for Oakcrest School to move forward.

The Committee has been meeting for the past several months and a meeting is scheduled for **Tuesday, January 21, 2014, 7:00-9:00 p.m.**, to share information with the larger community. The location is the Colvin Run Elementary School, 1400 Trap Road, Vienna, Virginia 22182.

NewPath Networks, LLC has filed a 2232 Review Application 2232-H13-11, to replace two (2) existing light poles and three (3) existing poles; install two (2) new utility poles and collocate six (6) antennas on each pole

for the use in a distributed antenna system (DAS). One (1) new cabinet will also be installed on each pole along with a required Dominion electrical meter. The antennas will be screened by a cylindrical sheath that will be painted to match the pole.
