September 9, 2014

PRESENTATIONS

The Board recognized **Jean Packard**, former Board of Supervisor Chairman and environmental leader, for her many years of service on numerous County and regional boards and commissions. Jean represented Fairfax County on the Northern Virginia Regional Park Authority Board (24 years) and served on the Northern Virginia Soil and Water Conservation District, Northern Virginia Conservation Trust, and the Virginia Soil and Water Conservation Board.



The Board declared September as **Sickle Cell Awareness Month**. Receiving the proclamation are Health Department Director Dr. Gloria Addo-Ayensu (*center right*) and Valerie Bey (*left*) from the County's Channel 16. This month's "Connecting with Supervisor Hudgins" cable television show is a discussion about sickle cell disease in our community. FY2014 Carryover Review and FY2015 Revised Budget Plan: The Board held a public hearing and approved the [FY2014 Budget Carryover package](#). In summary, \$11.0 million set aside in reserve for one-time FY2015 and FY2016 requirements.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Admin 1: The Board approved the addition of Shaker Woods Road (Route 680) to the State Secondary System.

Admin 5: The Board authorized the Department of Family Services to apply for and accept grant funding from the federal Department of Health and Human Services for **expansion of the Early Head Start** program. This will reach an additional 56 children.

ACTION ITEMS

Action 4: The Board approved an agreement for an interim Metrorail public commuter park-and-ride lot at the Tysons Station, providing 100 spaces for commuters.

Action 13: The Board approved a memorandum of understanding between Fairfax County and Volunteer Fairfax necessitated by the implementation of a consolidated **Volunteer Management System** (VMS) for the County.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Board held a public hearing and approved **election precincts and polling places changes** including the move of Terraset precinct voting to Hughes Middle School temporarily, as Terraset Elementary is undergoing renovation.
