ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Admin 9: The Board authorized Fairfax-Falls Church Community Services Board to apply for and accept funding to house people who are homeless and those at risk of homelessness who have severe and persistent mental health issues (SMI) and/or co-occurring SMI and substance use issues.

ACTION ITEMS

Action 1: The Board approved revisions to the County's Title VI program for the Federal Transit Administration that better define **transportation system-wide service standards**, disparate impact and disproportionate burden policies.

Action 5: The Board adopted the **One Fairfax Social Equity Resolution** to develop a racial and social equity policy and strategic actions to advance opportunities and achieve equity.

Action 6: The Board approved a prioritization process for ongoing development of projects in coordination with VDOT for the **county safety and operational improvements funding program**.
