April 4, 2017

PRESENTATIONS

The Board made the following designations in Fairfax County:

- April 9-15, 2017 - **Library Week**
- April 27, 2017 – **Holocaust Remembrance Day**
- April 2017 - **Child Abuse Prevention Month**

The board adopted a **resolution to reaffirm County's values on diversity and inclusion.**

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Admin 2: The Board approved traffic calming measures on Colts Brook Drive, in Reston.

Admin 6: The Board passed a resolution to adopt updates to the Northern Virginia Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan, as required to receive federal funding assistance. Having a Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) approved Hazard Mitigation Plan makes the participating jurisdictions eligible for Pre and Post Hazard Mitigation grant funding.

ACTION ITEMS

Action 1: The Board approved a Memorandum of Agreement between the County and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) regarding the **Child Exploitation Task Force (CETF)**. The mission of CETF is to provide a rapid, proactive, and intelligence-driven investigative response to the sexual victimization of children and other crimes against children.

Action 5: After conducting a public hearing, the Board approved the creation of a **Reston Transportation Service District Advisory Board**. The Advisory Board will provide input on the annual tax rate for the Service District, the transportation project priorities, and project implementation schedules.

INFORMATION ITEMS

Info 2: The County, on behalf of the Fairfax-Falls Church Community Services Board (CSB), will enter into a contract with the City of Alexandria for the provision of **methadone/suboxone detoxification clinic services** as needed for patients in Fairfax County.

Info 3: The County, on behalf of the Department of Human Resources (DHR) will enter into a contract with the Inova Health Care Services for the provision of **physical examinations and medical evaluations** for Fairfax County government and Fairfax County Public Schools.

Info 4: The County, on behalf of the Department of Human Resources (DHR) will enter into a contract with Korn Ferry Hay Group, Inc. to provide **compensation consulting services**.

PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Board held a public hearing and approved the creation of a Reston Transportation Service District. The Service District within the Reston Transit Station Areas (TSAs): Wiehle-Reston East, Reston Town Center, and Herndon, as set forth in the Comprehensive Plan.

The Board held a public hearing and approved Zoning Ordinance Amendments governing commercial vehicles in residential districts. The changes clarify what constitutes a commercial vehicle.

The Board held a public hearing and approved a new amendment to include workforce housing guidance for high-rise condominiums in the Comprehensive Plan for Tysons.
