### Responsibly Dispose of Your Household Hazardous Waste

Only household hazardous waste from Fairfax County residents will be accepted. Proof of residency is required (ex: utility bill, driver's license). **No Business or Commercial Waste!**

**Examples of what to bring:** acids, gasoline, fluorescent bulbs, fungicides, herbicides, insecticides, mercury products, oil-based paint, paint thinner, pesticides, poisons, pool chemicals, & rechargeable batteries (**no automobile batteries** - take these to one of our permanent HHW disposal facilities at the I-66 Transfer Station or the I-95 Landfill Complex).
