Madam Chairman— This year will be the 22nd annual Springfield Days celebration from Thursday, June 3 through Sunday, June 6.

Springfield Mall will be the site of the Family-Fest during all four days and will feature children's entertainment, games, rides, food and music.

On Friday, June 4 there will be a student film fest at American Legion Post 176. On Saturday, June 5, the South Run RECenter will host a Fitness Fest and a Family Fun Run. There will be complimentary workouts and fitness assessments, exercise demos, and raffles. Also on Saturday, the Springfield Art Guild will exhibit the works of local artists at the Springfield Mall venue. The ever popular annual PetFest and Paws-on-Parade will round out the Saturday events.

On Sunday, June 6 there will be an early morning Springfield run followed later by the annual Cardboard Boat Regatta at Lake Accotink Park.

This celebration has many partners that make this all possible including the Greater Springfield Chamber of Commerce, the Fairfax County Park Authority - Lake Accotink Park and South Run RECenter, the Springfield Art Guild, Colonial Animal Hospital, Leith Graphics, Springfield Mall, the Springfield Civic Association, the Fairfax County Police Department, American Legion Post 176 and generous sponsors from the local business community.
