



# Freading eBooks

The majority of the library's eBooks are offered through a service called Overdrive. Additional free eBooks for a variety of devices are available through a service called Freading. There are no late fees. Titles may not be returned early, and are returned automatically when the checkout period expires. They are checked out for a period of two weeks, and may be renewed once. The token borrowing system is explained below.

## Devices and Formats

*PC and Mac, Sony Reader, Kobo Reader, and Nook*

- **ePub** and **PDF** eBook format
- Download **Adobe Digital Editions** and authorize with an Adobe ID.

*Android phones and tablets, iPad, iPhone, iPod Touch, Nook Color and Nook Tablet*

- **ePub** and **PDF** eBook format
- Download the **Freading** app from your device's App Store and authorize with an Adobe ID.

*Kindle Fire*

- **ePub** and **PDF** eBook format
- See "How do I get the Freading app on my Kindle Fire?" under FAQ on the Freading website.

Freading does not support the Kindle format.

## Search for a Title

- Access <http://fairfaxcounty.freading.com> from a computer or portable device. On an Android device, you may search from the app. On an Apple device, use Safari, then download a title into the app.
- Search for a title, author, category or publisher. Use the checkmark boxes to limit by format.
- The library purchases a certain number of tokens for the system. After the system's annual allotment of tokens is used up, titles can be placed on hold.
- Each book is worth one, two or four tokens. Values are assigned by the publishers. Each library account is given five tokens per week to check out books. Unused tokens roll over to the next week.

## Download a Title

- Select Login in the upper right corner.
- If prompted, enter “Fairfax County” in the library name box, then select **Fairfax County Library**.
- When prompted, enter your library card number.
- Select a book title.
- Select **Download epub** or **Download pdf**. The cost in tokens is listed beneath the format(s).
- When prompted, select **Open**.
- The title will download either to Adobe Digital Editions or to the app.
- Transfer a title to a Nook, Nook Color, Sony Reader, or Kobo Reader by plugging the e-reader into your computer. The e-reader should show up in Adobe Digital Editions beneath Bookshelves in the left column. Select the library tab, right-click on the title, then click Copy to (name of e-reader).
- Safely disconnect the e-reader from your computer, then open the e-reader and enjoy the title.
