

Full Moon at the Napping House by Audrey Wood Activity



moon

Assembly:

1. Print on cardstock.
2. Cut out images using paper cutter to form even-sized rectangles (4.25x5 inches).
3. Laminate for durability and adhere to large craft sticks with English words on one side and Spanish on the other to create paddles for the children to hold (or print two copies of the same cards for English only).

Using with the book:

1. Read the book once before using with the activity to help with comprehension.
2. Show the children the book and talk about the last time you read it. Remind them there are many words that they will hear repeated in the story.
3. Show them the pictures on the paddles, asking what each picture is (and if using the Spanish cards, introduce the Spanish vocabulary as well).
4. Give each child a paddle to hold.
5. Ask them to listen carefully as you read the story and to raise their paddles when they hear their words.
6. Read the story. If you mention a word and the child does not raise his/her paddle, prompt, "Does anyone have the _____?"
5. If they are having fun and want to do it again, have the children switch paddles and read it again. Once they have the hang of it, you can get silly and read really fast to see how quickly than can raise their paddles.

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

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
