Community Meeting on the Development of North Hill Scheduled for April 27th

Mount Vernon Supervisor Dan Storck will host a community meeting on the development of North Hill on April 27, 2016 at Walt Whitman Middle School's Lecture Hall from 7:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.

Residents are invited to hear about the progress being made toward developing the North Hill area into a mix of affordable, workforce and market rate housing. The developer, CHPPENN I, LLC, as well as county representatives, will be present and available to answer questions from the community.

The North Hill development project is expected to bring to the community 278 affordable multi-family rental units in six separate, high quality, urban designed buildings with structured parking. In addition, up to 195 for-sale townhomes and acreage for a park.

Currently, the North Hill property consists of approximately 33 unimproved acres off of Richmond Highway in the Mount Vernon District of Fairfax County. Through the Public Private Education Facilities and Infrastructure Act of 2002 (PPEA), the County was able to pursue a public-private partnership to transform North Hill into a mixed income, affordable and market rate housing community at no cost to the County.
