*The Fairfax County Community Chaplain Corps provides spiritual care and pastoral crisis intervention to community members impacted by the effects of a disaster or emergency. The Community Chaplains work as a part of an emergency or disaster team under the directions of the locally designated incident management system and in cooperation with the Fairfax County Office of Emergency Management (OEM), Police Department, Fire and Rescue Department and Community Services Board (CSB). The Fairfax County Community Interfaith Coordination Office provides all administrative support.*

*All candidates must agree to a national criminal background check and a "Virginia Child Protective Services Registry" review. Professional references, to include leadership within applicants' affiliated religious body are to be provided.*
