




# SEVEN CORNERS AT-A-GLANCE

## AGE



## RACE/ETHNICITY

There are large Asian and Hispanic populations.

## HOUSEHOLD INCOME



**\$49,429**

is the median household income in Seven Corners.  
(\$112,102 for the County)

## HEALTHCARE



Approximately **23%** of the population in Seven Corners is without health insurance.  
(13% for the County)

## LABOR FORCE



At **4%**, the unemployment rate in Seven Corners is lower compared to the County's rate at 5%.

## HOUSING

**54%** of the renters in Seven Corners are cost-burdened.\*\*  
(44% for the County)



**27%** of the homeowners in Seven Corners are cost-burdened.\*\*  
(25% for the County)

\*\* Percentage of household income spent for mortgage costs or gross rent. According to HUD programs, households spending more than 30% of income for these housing costs are considered to be "cost-burdened."

## INDIVIDUALS WITH DISABILITIES



Approximately **8%** of the population in Seven Corners has one or more disabilities.  
(6% for the County)

## YOUTH

**38%** of the teens (8th-, 10th-, and 12th-grade) enrolled in the Stuart High School pyramid reported depressive symptoms according to the 2014 Fairfax County Youth Survey.  
(32% for the County)



**63%** of the students enrolled in the Stuart High School pyramid during the 2014-2015 school year were eligible for free and reduced-price lunch.  
(28% for the County)

## LANGUAGE

Almost **25%** of the non-English speaking population\* (age 5 and over) speak English "less than very well".  
(15% for the County average)



About **30%** of the Spanish speaking population\* (age 5 and over) speak English "less than very well".  
(14% for the County average)
