

## Program Information

Therapeutic Recreation Services' (TRS) summer programs are designed to provide individuals with the opportunity to engage in a variety of structured and free-choice activities which emphasize the development of leisure skills. Activities offered include sports, fitness, crafts, games, music, story telling, and special events. Community outings are offered to parks, swimming, and special events. A staff ratio of 1:4 is maintained to provide supervision and support to participants.

### Activities are selected that provide opportunities for the individual to:

- Increase or maintain his/her physical fitness
- Learn new leisure skills (specific to activities of interest)
- Socialize and interact with peers
- Select personal leisure choices
- Self-initiate play

Each week activities are planned and selected to complement a specific theme or special event. A schedule of activities will be provided weekly.




## Leisure Program Summer Leisure is Fun!


## Adventure Program Summer Camp is an Adventure!
