- Motivating teams and individuals in a positive manner.
- Focusing on long term goals, not just win/loss records.
- Promoting the concept that success is measured by individual and team effort, not by a scoreboard.
- Imparting knowledge and love of the game to the team in a positive manner.
- Taking responsibility for the behavior of self, team and parents.

Parent Awards

- Being respectful to players, coaches, and game officials.
- Treating all players, coaches and parents fairly.
- Recognizing the efforts of individual team members and opposing team members.
- Motivating parents, teams, coaches and fans in a positive manner.
- Promoting the concept that success is measured by individual and team effort, not by a scoreboard.
- Demonstrating good sportsmanship by approving and applauding good team play, individual skill, and good sportsmanship exhibited by players and coaches on both teams.
- Accepting volunteer roles to improve the communication and the needs of the coach and team.
