## Specialty Camps

Welcome to SACC Camp Discovery 2007 Specialty Camps – where imaginations take flight, and fun and laughter fill the air. This summer, campers can look forward to many new and traditional camp experiences as they jump into a summer of talent illuminating, creativity, and discovery. From camp songs and team cheers to outdoor excursions, there's something that's sure to capture each camper's interest. An adventure-filled summer awaits all!

### *Theatre Arts Camp*

Dazzling dance steps, foot-tapping musicals, heart-stopping dramas, hilarious comedies, and unpredictable improvisations await campers.

Four areas will offer campers the opportunity to explore and develop their creativity and talents in a variety of theatre arts.

- *Applause Performance Center*: acting, voice & diction, theatre games, memorization techniques, improvisation, plays, skits...
- *Music & Dance Studio*: stage movement, dance styles, choreography, voice, chorus...
- *Tech Shop*: props, set dressing, set construction, special effects, lighting, sound...
- *Gallery Studio*: creative writing, photography, print making, and design...

### *Sports Camp*

Non-stop action and fast-paced fun are the name of the game for children this summer. Each week offers campers an opportunity to develop their skills and self-confidence in a specific sport, while learning about teamwork and sportsmanship.

- Week 1. Soccer
- Week 2. Basketball
- Week 3. Baseball & Softball
- Week 4. Tennis
- Week 5. Volleyball
- Week 6. Track & Field
- Week 7. Flag Football

Skill building sessions will be offered for beginning, intermediate, and advanced levels.

As campers learn the fundamentals of each sport, stretching, fitness, nutrition, and safety will also be emphasized.

### *Wilderness Camp*

Outdoor explorations, nature studies, team challenges, and camp skill building opportunities await campers. If your child has a love of nature and the outdoors, this is the place to be.

- *Camping Skills*: knot tying, cooking, shelter building, tent construction, hammock-making, basic first aid, plant identification...
- *Outdoor Sports*: hiking, backpacking, fly fishing, kiting, orienteering, canoeing, team building challenges, Ultimate Frisbee...
- *Nature Experiences*: pond & stream exploration, owl pellet studies, bird watching, wildlife identification, tracking, animal rescue, journaling...
- *Arts*: nature photography, recycled sculptures, nature painting, wildlife prints, habitat designs, natural furniture...

### **Community Service Project:**

In partnership with the Fairfax County Police Department, campers will also have the opportunity to participate in a special community service project called "Recycled Cycles," learning the art of bicycle repair. Refurbished bikes will be donated to children in community shelters.

### **Please Remember:**

- Children must be walked into Camp Discovery each day and checked in with a staff member.
- Children should wear comfortable shoes and clothing appropriate for play.
- Snacks are provided in the morning and afternoon.
- A refrigerated packed lunch and beverage are provided each day.
- A snack and lunch menu will be posted near the sign-out area.
- Children must be signed out each evening on the parent sign-out board and a staff member informed that your child is leaving.
- Please be prepared to show staff a photo I.D. when your child is picked up.

### **Licensing Information & Health Forms**

#### ***Children enrolled in the SACC School Year Program:***

- Your child's Licensing Information for SACC Records form and School Entrance Health form will be transferred to your summer site.
- Please review your child's folder to make sure the Licensing Information form contains up-to-date information and confirm that we have a copy of your child's School Entrance Health Form.

#### ***Children enrolled in the Summer Camp Discovery Program only:***

- If your child does not attend the SACC School Year program, you will need to provide SACC with a copy of your child's School Entrance Health form, a completed Licensing Information for SACC Records form, and proof of your child's identity (birth certificate, report card, passport, or Social Security card).
- These forms must be received by your summer camp site no later than the Friday before your child's start date.

#### ***All families:***

- Virginia State Licensing requires a minimum of two persons who are available to pick up your child in the event of an emergency when you cannot be reached. This information must be provided on the Licensing Information form in order for staff to accept your child.

#### **Cancellation Reminder:**

- If your plans change, please remember that we ask for a minimum of 2 weeks notice to cancel service.
- Services must be cancelled in advance to avoid charges.
- Once a session has begun, no refunds or credits will be given.
