FUNDING DISCLAIMER LETTER

Dear Parents,

At this time Fairfax County's Child Care Assistance and Referral (CCAR) program is able to serve all *currently enrolled eligible families*. However, CCAR does have a waiting list.

The Virginia Department of Social Services has asked Fairfax County to make sure that your family is aware of the following information:

Child care funds for income eligible families like yours are limited. Income eligible families have a parent fee and pay their provider part of the costs of child care.

Child care funds for income eligible families change from year to year.

In Fairfax County parents who are eligible for child care assistance

- Work or participate in an approved education or training program.
- Need child care so they can work, go to school or participate in a training program.
- Meet Fairfax County income guidelines for the Child Care Assistance and Referral program.
- Can verify that they live in Fairfax County.

Child care funds for income eligible families cannot be guaranteed. If funding does end or run out, parents will receive at least 10 days written advance notice and their names will be placed on a waiting list.
