The Office for Women & Domestic and Sexual Violence Services offers a free, confidential support group for adult women who are currently experiencing or have previously experienced domestic abuse (physical, emotional, or verbal).

The group meets for eight weekly sessions and promotes understanding and healing from abuse trauma and builds a sense of community with other survivors.

All services are confidential, free (except ADAPT), and provided regardless of race, gender, ethnicity, national origin, age, disability, religion, or sexual orientation.
