Civil Rights Division**

**U.S. Department of Justice**

Thomas Perez was confirmed as Assistant Attorney General for the Justice Department's Civil Rights Division in 2009. From 1999 to 2001, he was Director of the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services Office of Civil Rights. Mr. Perez also served as the State of Maryland's Secretary of Labor, Licensing and Regulation. From 2001 to 2007, he was a professor at the University of Maryland School of Law. Mr. Perez is a graduate of Brown University and also the Kennedy School of Government and Law School at Harvard University.
